FALL 2 DAY TOUR  
OCTOBER 14 & 15, 2023  
Hershey/Baltimore

This year's KSC's fall two day trip will be to the Hershey and Baltimore area. We will be taking a charter bus from Werner Bus Company. The bus is equipped with air conditioning, tinted windows, a private lavatory, and wifi.

We will meet at 7:00-7:15AM at Boyertown Historic Vehicle Museum. The bus will depart at 7:30AM sharp. We will be adding a 2nd pick up location this year in Hershey, We will pick up any members who would like to join us there. We will then start our fun filled weekend with a visit to the Hershey AACA Museum/America's Transportation Experience, The AACA Museum at Hershey displays vintage automobiles in unique settings. Visitors stroll through eight decades in time while traveling from New York to San Francisco. It's a trip down "memory lane" as iconic settings reveal vehicles from generations of American motoring. After lunch we will go on a private tour of the AACA Library and Research Center. Don Barlup a KSC founder and AACA board member will help us on this tour. The library is one of the largest and most honored libraries of its type in the world. Currently they house about 2,000,000 individual items to help restorers and historians alike. The interior of the building is split into 2 levels. The **main entry level** features rotating exhibits, art displays, and antique cars. The **upper level** contains their huge assortment of Periodicals and



Magazines, The Hudson-Essex-Terraplane Historical Society Collection, and The Ralph Dunwoodie Archives, as well as their collection of automotive literature including sales brochures, service manuals, reference books, owners manuals, special collections, shop manuals, marque specific books, and much more. After the library, we will get the "Behind the Scenes Tour" of the AACA museum with Hank Hallowell. Hank is a KSC member and board member of the AACA museum. Hank lives in the Hershey area and houses one of his collection in the former site H. B. Smith Pontiac/Oakland dealership. If time permits we will make a quick stop here, too. From here we will stop for dinner on the way to our hotel in New Cumberland PA. You will have the evening to rest and relax.

**Hotel** - We will be staying at the Holiday Inn Express in New Cumberland PA at 190 Beacon Hill Boulevard, New Cumberland, PA 17070 their phone number is 717-774-6400. **You will be**

**responsible for calling the hotel to make your own reservations** from the blocked rooms we have reserved. **Ask for Stacy when you call and use “Pontiac Club”** when making reservations to get our special room rate of \$149. + tax and \$159. + tax. Rooms must be reserved prior to Sept 1st or they get returned to the hotel. Please reserve early, October is a busy travel month and we could only block 20 rooms. We will need one for the bus driver, leaving us with 19 rooms on a first come first serve basis.



**On Sunday,** we will start our day with a warm breakfast at our hotel. We will then board the bus for Baltimore. Our first stop of the day will be at the National Aquarium. The National Aquarium’s mission is to inspire conservation of the world’s aquatic treasures, We will experience dozens of unique aquatic habitats—from a northern Australian river gorge to an Indo-Pacific reef to a tropical rain forest—all interconnected by the binding force of water. You will be on your own to walk through the aquarium at your own pace. Don’t forget to check out the free talks throughout your visit. After you have walked through the

aquarium, the exit will place you in the inner harbor area where you will find many choices to eat lunch before returning to the bus. In the afternoon we will go to Fort McHenry for a patriotic end to our weekend. The valiant defense of the fort during the Battle of Baltimore on September 13-14, 1814 inspired Francis Scott Key to write the words that became the U.S. national anthem. The fort's history holds many other stories too, from the Civil War to WWII. We will start our visit at the visitor center and watch a movie to learn the history before we take our self guided tour through the fort.



**The cost** - Your individual costs will include - Saturday lunch and dinner, Sunday lunch, entrance to Fort McHenry, and hotel room. We will need to collect (on the bus) the driver tip (suggested \$2 per person per day = \$4 per person. You can tip more if you feel the driver did a great job)

This year’s pre-paid deposit of \$95. will include all entrance fees except Fort McHenry and the AACA museum, if you are not AACA members. This \$95. per person deposit is non refundable. This will be used to pay towards the clubs cost of prepaid tickets to the aquarium, AACA tour, drivers room and a portion of the bus. We will divide the driver’s room price by the total number of attendees and may have to be adjusted more or less depending on number of attendees. While the deposit is higher than last year, we were able to get our rooms at a lower rate and our meal costs have flexibility.

Final itinerary will be sent to all registered participants.
