2 Day Fall Tour of the Northern Tier Counties

We will be conducting a 2 day fall tour to the Northern section of the State the weekend of September 14-15, 2019. The tour will leave from Williamsport at 11 AM on Saturday, September 14th. We will travel north to Sullivan County, and after a brief stop in historic Eagles Mere, Pa. we will travel the short distance to the renowned Eagles Mere auto and antique airplane museums. This consists of 2 separate museum buildings, one for cars, and one for antique planes. Both museum buildings are fairly new, and quite well done. The wealthy owner has a passion for tri-five Chevys, and you will see all variations of those marque cars. Additionally, many other interesting makes of autos are on display, including a number of special Pontiacs. The air museum houses a nice collection of vintage aircraft, and often they will have some of them flying for your enjoyment. We will then proceed north to Towanda, Pa., for dinner and our overnight stay. First day mileage starting at Williamsport is about 70 miles to our overnight destination at Towanda.

On Sunday morning, we will drive across the northern tier, on the well-known historic and scenic Route 6, which stretches across the entire state. Our approximate 60 mile journey will bring us to the historic Penn Wells hotel in the beautiful small town Wellsboro, for their widely acclaimed Sunday morning brunch. After a great meal, we will proceed a short distance to the Pennsylvania Grand Canyon lookout on the East Canyon Rim. You can spend as much time enjoying the spectacular view as you like, and if you are so inclined, there are a number of hiking trails you can try.

We will then return to Williamsport, for a day 2 driving distance of about 135 miles from Towanda to Williamsport, where the tour concludes. Total mileage for both days starting at, and returning to Williamsport is about 205 miles.

Anyone who desires to see my extensive Lionel model train collection, can arrive prior to 11 AM on Saturday, or stop by when we return from the tour on Sunday afternoon. Allow ample time as there is plenty to see, with 18 operating tracks, and the very latest in Lionel Legacy wireless control system features.
