For our May activity we will return to the Lancaster area, to visit the Pennsylvania State Railroad Museum on **Saturday, May 13th**. This is an extensive and very impressive collection of locomotives and cars used by the Pennsy railroad in years past. Having been to a number of other state railroad museums, this extensive collection is as nice as any others I have seen. PRR was long considered the gold standard for other railroads to aspire to. Indoors you will find many completely restored locomotives, cars, and other pieces of railroad history. In the turntable area outdoors, are stored many interesting engines and other historical units, awaiting their turn for restoration to their former glory. Plan to arrive around Noon, and the museum is self-guided, so you can spend your time examining the pieces that catch your interest.
