

Pontiac's trademark split-grille returned to stay for '61. The Ventura Sport Coupe was the combination of Bonneville luxury and Catalina sveltness. Three two-barrel carbs on the 389 meant all business from under the hood. Eight-lug wheel combined beauty and function. Improved brake cooling came as a result of the wheel rim bolted to the outer portion of the aluminum brake drum. The "Jewelstone Morrokide" upholstery was handsome and standard on Ventura.




